<b>Description</b> Steps to reproduce: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Enable WiFi and connect to local wifi network</li><li>- Connect to XMPP via Beem</li><li>- Walk out of area of Wifi until interface switches from Wifi to 4G</li></ul> Result: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Beem no longer running</li></ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Restart Beem while connected via 4G</li><li>- Walk back to Wifi-covered area</li></ul> Result: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Beem no longer running</li></ul> Very frustrating when using Beem to seamlessly transition from home office to surrounding area (like walking down the street to buy a coke).
